

# History


- Concrete channel built early 1980s
- For flood and erosion protection
- Several drop structures
- Flows into Victoria Park Lake



# Victoria Park Lake EA



- Address sedimentation
- Public driven
- Dredging ~15 years
- Upstream source of sediment
- Completed in 2009
- \$16 Million



# Funding the Work



- Stormwater Utility
  - 2011, transferred stormwater funding property taxes to a user-fee program
  - **↑**imperviousness = **↑**higher rate
  - Public attended 2011 Council budget meeting

- Construction 2011/2012



# Upstream Works Begin



- Hired consultant (Stantec) – Spring 2013
  - Included removal of 4 km of concrete channel
  - Addition of 2 SWM Facilities at Filsinger Park



# Purpose



Remove concrete:

- Improve water quality
- Reduce sediment loading
- Enhance natural habitat



# Public Acceptance

- Petition to stop SWM Facility at Park
- Community Garden concerns
- Opposition to tree removal



# Public Outreach



- Enewsletters with progress
- Website updates
- CBC radio interview prior to work
- Responses
  - Extremely good
  - “Beautiful”, “Now I understand”



# Lessons Learned




- Changed City PM at tender stage- not ideal
- Pre-qualification vs. qualified bidder process
- More flexible construction window
- Don't tender in May to start in July!
- Find ways to engage public



# Design

- Existing Conditions:
  - ~ 2,500 m of steep concrete channel  
(up to 2%)
  - Tributary area  
~12 km<sup>2</sup>
  - Urban land uses

# Design Criteria

- Natural channel design with stable pattern, dimension, profile
- Enhance habitat features
- Maintain flood elevations
- Improve water quality

# Design Elements





- No natural reaches on site – mini-regional curve & reference reaches
- Meandering planform, profile and cross sections
- Floodplain assessment




# Design Elements

- 3D design
  - Optimize design with iterations
  - Enables GPS construction
- Structures
- Planting Plans







# Lessons Learned

- Existing Conditions:
  - Infrastructure, neighbours
  - Floodplain limits
- Design Elements:
  - Urban system
  - Structures (urban drainage – fine sediment, tree re-use)
  - 3D design
- Approvals

# Construction



- Layout:
  - GPS Systems in equipment greatly increased productivity
  - As-builts were virtually identical to design drawings
- Experienced operators & the right equipment




# Construction



- Access:
  - Due to wet conditions, the existing channel was used as a haul road
  - Don't be afraid to modify methodology
- Dewatering:
  - Flume pipe vs. pumping or diversion
- Final landscaping immediately followed channel construction


